SCRIPTURE REFERENCE:

- Hebrews 11:33-34
- Romans 12:2
- Hebrews 11:13-16
- Daniel 1:1-7

Connect: Grow together

1. How did God show up in your life this week?
2. What are you thankful for since the last time we met? Stressed about?
3. Did you follow through on any action steps from last time? How did it go?

Discover: Let the words sink in

1. What was the main point of this week’s message, in your own words?
2. What jumped out at you?
3. What did this message say about God and about people? If this is true and you acted on it, how might this change your life?
4. How will you apply what you learned before we meet again?
5. Create an “I will” statement based on the message.

Challenge Questions:

1. This week we launched a new series in the Old Testament book of Daniel unpacking the idea of becoming “An Influential Minority” and we talked about living in “the in-between”. After reflecting on Hebrews 11 and the seemingly catastrophic events of Daniel chapter 1, what is the tension of living in ‘the in-between’?
2. What are the challenges of living in an empire that is markedly distinct from the kingdom of Jesus? What is the goal of the empire? How do they accomplish their goal?

Bonus: Do you see similarities between Babylon and the culture that we live in today? In what way?

Multiply: Share the Love

1. Are there any concerns/difficulties that you are currently facing? Is there any way that the group can help?
2. Who else can the group show kindness to?
3. Do you know someone who could benefit from hearing what you have learned?
