Connect: Grow together

1. How did God show up in your life this week?

3. Did you follow through on any action steps from last time? How did it go?

Discover: Let the words sink in

1. What was the main point of this week's message, in your own words?
2. What jumped out at you?
3. What did this message say about God and about people? If this is true and you acted on it, how might this change your life?
4. How will you apply what you learned before we meet again?
5. Create an "I will" statement based on the message.

Challenge Questions:

1. Brad asks the question, 'How is it possible that our faith grows in some of the worst times?' Answer that question personally.
2. Jesus cares more about our trust than our comfort. How uncomfortable does that make you feel? What are some things in your life that need to change to help you trust God more and be less comfortable?
3. What has God shown you in the midst of hardship? How has God changed you through your circumstances?

Multiply: Share the Love

1. Are there any concerns/difficulties that you are currently facing? Is there any way that the group can help?
2. Who else can the group show kindness to?
3. Do you know someone who could benefit from hearing what you have learned?
