Connect: Grow together

1. How did God show up in your life this week?
2. What are you thankful for since the last time we met? Stressed about?
3. Did you follow through on any action steps from last time? How did it go?

Discover: Let the words sink in

1. What was the main point of this week's message, in your own words?
2. What jumped out at you?
3. What did this message say about God and about people? If this is true and you acted on it, how might this change your life?
4. How will you apply what you learned before we meet again?
5. Create an "I will" statement based on the message.

Challenge Questions:

1. In week number two of our series "Meaningless" we discussed the difference between infinity and eternity. In your own words, how would you describe the difference? What does it mean that in Ecclesiastes 3:11 we are told that eternity is placed in our hearts? What is the significance that this statement is made in contrast to "time"? What does this tell you about what God is trying to get us to understand, or see, or experience? How does that compare to how most of us are living? How does this challenge you?
2. We discussed the keys to experiencing 'ha-olam' and discovered that much of it has to do with letting our past go, and paying less attention to the future. How does the work and ministry of Jesus help you accomplish this? How is your past keeping you from being present in the moment? How are your thoughts on the future impacting your ability to be here, now?

Multiply: Share the Love

1. Are there any concerns/difficulties that you are currently facing? Is there any way that the group can help?
2. Who else can the group show kindness to?
3. Do you know someone who could benefit from hearing what you have learned?
