Connect: Grow together

1. How did God show up in your life this week?
2. What are you thankful for since the last time we met? Stressed about?
3. Did you follow through on any action steps from last time? How did it go?

Discover: Let the words sink in

1. What was the main point of this week's message, in your own words?
2. What jumped out at you?
3. What did this message say about God and about people? If this is true and you acted on it, how might this change your life?
4. How will you apply what you learned before we meet again?
5. Create an "I will" statement based on the message.

Challenge Questions:

1. This past Sunday Brad taught from Galatians 2:11-21; a text that discusses a conflict between the apostle Paul and the apostle Peter. After looking at the text, what was the source of the conflict between Peter and Paul?
2. Why was this such a significant issue for Paul?
3. In what ways can we be guilty of the same behavior? In other words, what does that look like in our culture today? What are the reasons we gravitate toward these types of behaviors?
4. Discuss together how a life based on the gospel is different than a life based on religion. What does that really look like on a practical level?
5. Is there a specific way that you feel challenged by this right now?

Multiply: Share the Love

1. Are there any concerns/difficulties that you are currently facing? Is there any way that the group can help?
2. Who else can the group show kindness to?
3. Do you know someone who could benefit from hearing what you have learned?
